All club confirmation pings have been sent out to our families that have signed up for clubs.

All payment items have been added onto ParentPay for you to make payment, the deadline for payment is **Friday 15th May**.

Club Rules:

- ◆ You must not use clubs as childcare, your child **MUST** want to take part in that club as we have limited spaces for each club so please make sure it is something your child wants to partake in.
- ◆ Payments must be received by **Friday 15th May** and refunds will **NOT** be issued if your child withdraws from the club.
- ◆ All clubs (except for Football/Multisports/PAN & Ukulele) end at 4pm promptly. If children are collected late more than two times in a term, the child will be removed from the club.
- ◆ Children are expected to behave well and take part in the club. If we have issues with behaviour or disinterest, children will be removed from the club to make way for someone on the waiting list.
- ◆ Teachers and TA's who run the clubs give their time for free and are not paid- we are very grateful to staff who volunteer their time so to reiterate please only pick a club/clubs that your child will be interested in and please make sure you are not late to collect your child from clubs.
