Holy Communion Plans

First Holy Communion is this **Saturday**, you should have received a letter detailing all the plans and what your child needs to wear (this was also sent on a Ping).

There are medals for the boys and girls (boys will have theirs on pins attached to their clothes and the girls will have these on red ribbon), also there are sashes for all children to wear
- The medals, pins, ribbon and sashes will be provided for your child.

The boys will need to wear Holy Communion ties which should have all been sent home if purchased through school.

Drop off plans—Children should be dropped off at the parish centre no later than **10:30am**. This will allow time to organise the children, go through final preparations, and help them feel calm and ready before Mass begins.

All family members and guests should be seated and ready for Mass to begin by **10:55am**. Each child will have a reserved bench with their name on.

Families are welcome to sit together on this bench; however, if there are additional guests, we kindly ask that they make use of the benches further back.

Professional photographs of each child will be taken after Mass in the parish centre. Once the children have processed out, they will be guided to the parish centre for their photos. Parents can then collect their child from there once their photographs have been taken. There is also an option to have a professional family photograph taken, please let someone know after Mass if you would like this.

The church have also asked us to share with our families and visitors that the touchline carpark is open for you to use, however the church have had some complaints of visitors blocking their staff and customers in, please be mindful about blocking any cars in on the Touchline carpark. If there are no marked spaces on the carpark then please find somewhere else to park. The church have also asked that there is no food to be consumed on the premises.
