WhatsApp

Reminder to all parents that we advise that children do not go on WhatsApp at home or that parents monitor their child's WhatsApp chats at home please. If they become upset or if there is any concerning content we ask for them to block and delete it.

We are having to manage fall outs that have happened outside of school and it is detrimental to the children.

WhatsApp has a **minimum age requirement of 13 years** (and in some regions higher). This age limit exists because children under this age may not yet have the emotional maturity, digital awareness, or judgment needed to navigate online communication safely and responsibly.

We strongly encourage parents to:

- Check the age requirements of apps before allowing their use.
- Discuss online safety and appropriate behaviour with their children.
- Set clear rules and boundaries around messaging, screen time, and group chats.
- Regularly talk with your child about their online experiences and any concerns they may have.
